The most outstanding original poster proposal will receive funding to attend the conference and stay at the conference hotel (maximum award \$225) as well as a certificate of achievement. Selection will be made by September 1, 2006. [Note: to be eligible you will need to have been a LIS student in the 2005-2006 school year.]

A poster is a visual presentation of a project or research you have done in the field of library and information science.
